



The SCB is seeking nominations for new members of the Board of Governors. The following offices are open:

In order to undertake its business effectively the Board needs members with the full range of experience and expertise necessary for overseeing the work of the Society. Following consideration of the current Board members, the schedule of retirements, and of significant tasks for the Society over the next few years, we particularly welcome nominations, or self-nominations, from individuals with experience and interests in the following areas:

- international policy
- scientific publications

There is also a continuing need for individuals on the Board with experience, and an active interest, in Development and Fundraising and in social sciences. Positions on the Board, however, are not restricted to these topics.

Nominees must be SCB members in good standing. By agreeing to stand for election, nominees indicate their willingness to serve SCB by attending, generally at their own expense, all Board of Governors meetings during their three-year (Members at Large) or six-year (President Elect; two years each as President Elect, President and Past President) term of office that begins July 2011. Board meetings occur at each annual meeting (rarely conflicting with concurrent sessions). Another Board meeting is held in February or March (location varies).

Nominations will be accepted until 1 October 2010. Candidates for each office will be selected by the Governance Committee. Ballots are available for approximately 60 days in the first quarter of 2011. The ballot will be made available to SCB members in good standing via the SCB Web site and a paper ballot in the February newsletter.
