Transparent, evidence-based outcomes

- Independence of science gathering, reporting, and decision-making from political biases
- Transparent and inclusive decision-making that includes concurring and minority opinions (that are supported by evidence), and recognition and quantification of uncertainty wherever possible
- Precautionary approach in the absence of sufficient information
